




Olive Kitteridge is an indomitable and compassionate retired schoolteacher in a small coastal town in Maine


John Rebus is on trial for a crime that could put him behind bars for life. Meanwhile, **Detective Inspector** Siobhan Clarke faces Edinburgh's most




Former soap-star Adele Rafferty is replacing the lead actress at the last minute in a horror movie, and she CATHERINE can't help but nope can't help but hope

But something isn't quite right about the film. When strange goings-on in the script start to happen on set too, Adele begins to fear that the real horror lies off the page



The Aylward women of Nenagh are mad about each other, but you wouldn't always think it. Their story involves wives and windows,


gunrunners and gougers, sinners and saints.

As he goes round the houses making deliveries, he feels the past rising up to meet him – and encounters the complicit silences of a small community controlled by the Church.




