Love In The Fast Lane by Tyra Prince



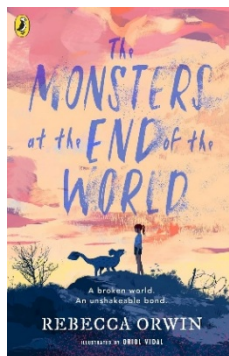

A Murder Is Announced by Agatha Christie



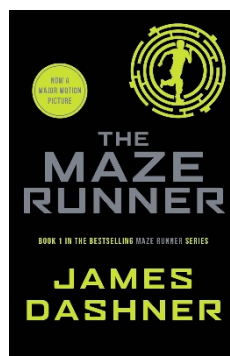
